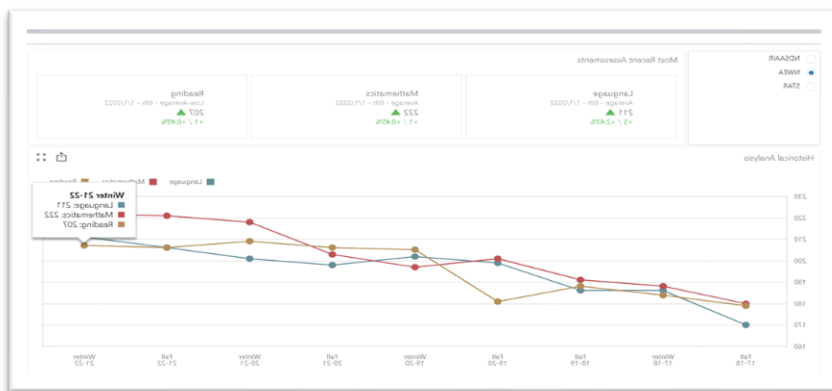
Assessment Dashboard

Are you looking for a place to see individual student's historical assessment data? The Assessment Dashboard in the Student Roster can give you just that. It is a "running record" of all interim and formal assessments that a student has taken since enrolling in a North Dakota public school system.

The school must be using PowerSchool to obtain all records

- How does the student's assessments compare to classroom performance?
- Does the trend show a need for intervention implementation/MTSS?
- Is the student showing College readiness when looking at ACT?

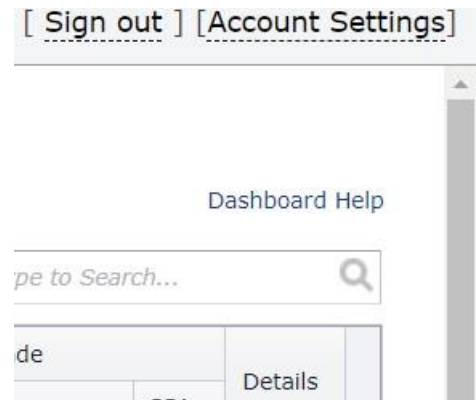
WHAT'S NEW?!

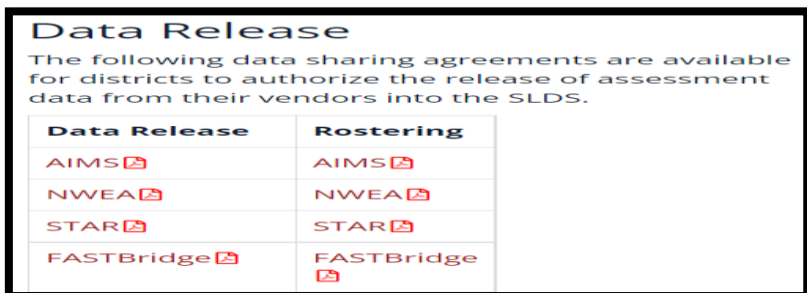
