
What are the employment and/or re-enrollment rates for NDUS graduates one year after degree completion?

The objective of this report is to show the rates at which North Dakota University System (NDUS) graduates are retained in the state of North Dakota for employment and/or continuing education in the NDUS. Throughout this report, retention is defined as a student being identified as having an enrollment in an NDUS institution or a non-zero quarterly wage one year after the completion of their first degree in the University System. Wages are obtained via the North Dakota Job Service Unemployment Insurance wage system, and do not include individuals who are self-employed. The students included in this study completed a degree in the North Dakota University System between Spring 2007 to Spring 2017.

Overall retention rate of NDUS graduates by year 2007-2017


Figure 1: Retention of NDUS degree completers one year post-degree, Spring 2007 - Spring 2017

Figure 1 below shows the retention rate of NDUS graduates one year following degree completion by the year in which they completed their first degree. The retention rate includes graduates who remained in North Dakota for employment and/or re-enrollment in NDUS.

Retention rates by high school state

Retention of NDUS graduates by high school state and year




Figure 3: Retention of NDUS degree completers by high school state and year, 2007 - 2017

Figure 3 and Table 2 below show the retention of NDUS graduates for employment and/or re-enrollment by both the state in which they graduated high school and the year in which they completed their first degree in NDUS. The group **surrounding states** includes Montana, South Dakota, and Minnesota.

Retention of NDUS graduates by high school state One year after first degree completion

Retention of NDUS graduates by degree level One year after first degree completion




Figure 4: Retention of NDUS degree completers by degree level and year, 2007 - $2017\,$

Retention of NDUS graduates from ND high schools One year after Associate Degree completion




Figure 5: Retention of North Dakota high school graduates who complete an Associate Degree




Figure 6: Retention of North Dakota high school graduates who complete a Bachelor Degree
